## **GRAINS/BREADS: MAKE IT COUNT!**

Child Care Food Program

Grain-based dessert foods will not be creditable on the Child Care Food Program beginning October 1, 2017. Non-creditable grain items cannot contribute towards a reimbursable meal. Creditable grain items must be in the correct portion for the age group served and must be whole grain, enriched, or made from whole grain or enriched meal or flour. Prepackaged products must have whole grain or enriched flour or meal as the first ingredient. At least one serving per day, across all eating occasions, must be 100% whole grain.
